



**MOTION REGARDING
WITNESS SCHEDULING**

NOW COMES the Maine Association of Health Plans (“MEAHP”), by and through its undersigned attorney, and respectfully requests that the Superintendent accommodate the following witness scheduling limitations:

As designated on its list of witnesses, MEAHP will be calling Mr. Tobin of CIGNA as a witness regarding the Hospital Initiatives (“COM” and “CMAD”) and the underwriting gain (“UG”) issue. Counsel to MEAHP was recently advised that Mr. Tobin cannot be available on Monday, October 24, but will be available to testify on either Thursday, October 27 or Friday, October 28.

In addition, MEAHP will be filing testimony from Dr. Fishbein of Aetna regarding Hospital Initiatives. Counsel to MEAHP was advised yesterday that Dr. Fishbein cannot be available on Friday, October 28, but will be available to testify on either Monday, October 24 or Thursday, October 27.

On the evening of October 19, counsel to MEAHP, notified all other counsel in this case of these constraints, requesting that he be informed of any objection to scheduling MEAHP’s witnesses in accordance with these constraints by noon today. MEAHP has not been notified of


any objection. In addition, MEAHP contacted counsel for Dirigo Health Agency (“DHA”) by telephone and we are authorized to represent that DHA has no objection to this motion. The Maine State Chamber of Commerce and the Trusts have advised MEAHP that they have no objection to this motion.
